

AMENDMENT TO THE CLARK COUNTY REPUBLICAN CENTRAL COMMITTEE BYLAWS

THEREFORE, THE MEMBERS OF THE CCRCC AMEND THE COMMITTEE BYLAWS AS FOLLOWS:

Clark County Republican Bylaws, Article XI, is amended to read as follows:

Article XI ORGANIZATIONAL MEETINGS

Section 1. The organizational meeting of the CCRCC shall be held in the manner prescribed in the **RCW 29A.80.030** and **29A.80.061**.

Section 2. The Chair, with consent of the retiring Board, shall determine the time and place of the organizational meeting.

Section 3. The Officers of the retiring Board shall cause notice of the time and place of the meeting to be mailed to each duly elected PCO at least ten (10) days prior to the meeting date.

Section 4. The order of business at the biennial organizational meeting aforementioned shall include, without limitation:

- a) Reading of call
- b) Adoption of Temporary Organization of the Meeting
- c) Roll Call
- d) Permanent Organization of the Meeting
- e) Adoption of Rules of the Meeting
- f) Adoption of Bylaws
- g) Nomination(s) and Election of County Chair and Vice-Chair
- h) Nomination(s) and Election of State Committeeman
- i) Nomination(s) and Election of State Committeewoman
- j) Nomination(s) and Election of Treasurer
- k) Nomination(s) and Election of Secretary
- l) Re-adoption of formerly adopted Core Principles per Article XX Section 3
- ↳m) Standing Committee Registration
- ↳n) Caucus by District to nominate and elect Legislative District Chairs and Directors
- ↳o) New Business
- ↳p) Good of the Order
- ↳q) Adjournment

Section 5. Contested elections of officers shall be by secret ballot. No proxies shall be recognized at the organizational meeting.

Section 6. Contested elections, where there are three (3) or more candidates, shall require the winning candidate to receive a majority of votes cast. If no candidate receives a majority, the candidate with the least number of votes shall be eliminated and another round of balloting shall take place. This process will continue until a candidate receives a majority of votes cast.

Section 7. During the Standing Committee Registration, the chair of the organizational meeting shall call forward each standing committee chair. If, for any reason, a standing committee chair has ceased to be eligible, a temporary chair shall be appointed by the organizational meeting chair. A reasonable period of time shall then be granted to allow PCOs to sign up (in writing) as members of the standing committees.

II. Clark County Republican Bylaws, Article XIV, is amended to read as follows:

Article XIV CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETINGS

Section 9. The agenda for the first quarterly meeting following the CCRCC organizational meeting shall include a call to meeting for each standing committee that has yet to hold its own organizational meeting.
