

Auditing the Republican National Committee's Use of Donations to Support Election Integrity Efforts Related to the 2020 Election

Whereas, Every American voter, and in particular, Washington State voters have a right to reasonable assurance of election integrity, but due to the pandemic, many election rules were changed or modified without the approval of the state legislatures, therefore 'relaxing' many of the rules that were codified by state legislatures to ensure a fair election, whereby only legal votes were to be counted; and

Whereas, The Republican National Committee (RNC) raised record funds under the pretext of supporting President Donald Trump, using his likeness, name, and messages before and after the potentially stolen election in 2020, and said funds were apparently not spent for the purposes of demanding accountability and transparency during and after the 2020 election; and

Whereas, The RNC and GOP at large have a vested interest in building confidence in our election systems for future election cycles; and

Now therefore be it resolved, that the Clark County Republican Party Election Integrity TEAM (CCRP EIT) demands that the Washington State Republican Party will join other organizations in demanding a forensic audit in all 50 states; and

Be it further resolved, that CCRP EIT calls for the RNC to immediately direct at least the \$80 million which was unspent at the end of 2020, according to FEC reporting, and any funds raised under the guise of Election Integrity to be directed to support forensic audits in all 50 states; and

Be it further resolved that CCRP EIT demands that should the audit results show that the RNC spent donations raised specifically under a campaign to address Election Integrity for other purposes, that the RNC will re-allocate general fundraising dollars to fund forensic audits in all 50 states; and

Be it further resolved, that CCRP EIT demands that the RNC allow President Donald J. Trump, or his assignee, to be given full decision-making and funding allocation for said funds, as well as the selection of the auditors and legal fees associated with said audit, and

Be it further resolved that CCRP EIT demands that the RNC provide transparency to the American People and RNC donors with the spending and allocation of those funds on a monthly basis; and

Be it finally resolved that CCRP EIT calls for the Washington State Republican Party vote to replace all of the current leadership in the RNC should the audit results not be made in a fully transparent manner to the satisfaction of the true leader of the Grand Old Party, President Donald J. Trump.
